Memorandum of Understanding
between the Investigative Committee of the Republic of
Armenia and the General Inspection Organization of
Islamic Republic of Iran

The Investigative Committee of the Republic of Armenia and the General Inspection Organization of the Islamic Republic of Iran (hereinafter referred Parties);

Desire to strengthen friendly and collaborative relations between Parties in the field of anti-corruption, Human Rights protection, handling complaints and other duties pertaining to tasks and purposes of each side, and thus contribute to the protection of individual rights in their respective countries on the basis of equality and mutual benefits, and in accordance with the laws and regulations of the laws and regulations of their respective countries;

Have agreed as follows;

Article I

Subject of Cooperation

The Parties decide to cooperate in anti-corruption, Human Rights protection, handling complaints and other duties pertaining to tasks and purposes of each side.

Article II

Areas of Cooperation

1. Exchange of experiences and information in the field of anti-corruption, Human Rights protection, handling complaints and other duties pertaining to tasks and purposes of each side, including information of legislative acts and important decisions taken by state bodies;

2. Exchange delegations or experts in order to share experiences on the work of anti-corruption, Human Rights protection, handling complaints and other duties pertaining to tasks and purposes of each side, in line with the previously-agreed plan under which the Parties would discuss a future exchange program.
3. The Parties will organize forums, workshops, seminars and conferences, and ensure coordination and provision of mutual assistance at multilateral forums on handling complaints and other duties pertaining to tasks and purposes of each side.

Article III

Implementation

1. Activities described in this Memorandum of Understanding will be implemented through the development of specific plans, programs or projects between the Parties. Such plans, programs and projects will specify the objectives, financial arrangements of the Parties;
2. The working language of Parties is English;
3. The Parties designate a representative as the Contact Person as follows:

For the General Inspection Organization of Islamic Republic of Iran, the Contact Person will be the International Office of General Inspection Organization.

For the Investigative Committee of the Republic of Armenia the Contact Person will be the International Office of the Investigative Committee of Armenia.



Article IV

Expenses

1. The financial agreements for matters of cooperation will be agreed by the Parties in each specific case;
2. Each Party will bear its own expenses for International travel, accommodation and meals necessitated by the exchange; the Party that receives the delegation will bear the expenses for the domestic travel due to participation in the exchange program and other items deemed appropriate by the Parties; other details regarding expenses will be decided between the two sides on a case-by-case basis.

Article V

Confidentiality of Information

The information of documents obtained from the other side will be kept confidential and will not be disseminated to any third party without prior consent in writing from the side which provided the information or documents. In the case where the provision of information contradicts legislation, public security or the norms of public regulations, Parties may deny the requests from the third parties.

Article VI

Modifications

By the mutual consent the Parties can made modifications or amendments in this Memorandum of Understanding, which will be formulated by separate Protocols, which will became the integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding and will enter into force according to provisions of the Article 8,

Article VII

The disputes and disagreements concerning to implementation or interpretation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled through consultations or negotiations between Parties.
